

Cambridge firm busy with poultry products

Grand River Foods in Cambridge, a company that began production only in March, has been doing such a booming business the owners are already thinking of expansion.

Craig Richardson, president of Grand River Poultry in Paris, Ont., which runs the Cambridge facility, says the 35,000-square-foot plant started with 35 employees, but now has 100.

“We added a second shift and we didn’t anticipate having to do that at this stage. We are performing at a level that we expected to be at in about our third or fourth year.”

Grand River Foods produces seasoned, cooked chicken products — such as chicken breasts, wings, fingers and nuggets — that are sold to both restaurants and grocery stores.

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
